

Teacher Selection Process

- Thank you for your interest in Wauhatchie Forest School and nature immersion education!
- Please email your responses to <u>office@wauhatchie.org</u>. Receipt of applications will be confirmed as soon as possible.
- Applications should include:
 - 1. Resume with a summary of all teaching experience relevant to the desired position
 - 2. Cover letter to include answers to the questions below
 - 3. Brief description of degrees earned and copy of transcripts (unofficial copies are satisfactory for the initial application; see below)
- Completed reference forms from at least three individuals, i.e. work supervisors, colleagues or parents of former students. Two of the three references should be former employers.
- Incomplete applications may not be considered.
- Finalists are required to submit official copies of all transcripts of coursework.
- Wauhatchie School will do a preliminary reference check as part of the initial screening of applications.
- Consideration for all positions is ongoing. Please return your application information as soon as possible.

Provide answers to these questions in your cover letter.

- 1. Write briefly about your philosophy of teaching.
- 2. What are some of the "tools" you would use for handling conflicts between children?
- 3. How important are observation, reflection, and documentation to you in working with children and growing as an educator? Explain your preferred method of documentation.
- 4. Describe forest school philosophy in your own words.
- 5. What are your strengths in relation to this job?
- 6. Have you ever participated in nature/forest school training or related workshops? What were they and describe your experience.
- 7. How would you describe your current level of knowledge concerning the stages of child-development?
- 8. What is most rewarding to you about being a forest school teacher?
- 9. Answer this question only if you are applying for K-5 teaching position: How would you incorporate STEAM, literacy or math lessons in a way that is complementary to forest school philosophy?
- 10. What makes you the best candidate for this position?
- 11. What position are you applying for?
- 12. What site do you prefer?
